Subject: Charcoal canister inspection - F 650 CS

Details: On early production examples of the F 650 CS model, the possibility exists that a plastic protective cap, used to preserve the integrity of the charcoal canister during shipping, was not removed during final motorcycle assembly. If the cap is not removed, this could lead, in some circumstances, to a rough running engine.

Aftersales Solution: During the set-up and PDI, or a routine service, inspect the charcoal canister and remove the cap if necessary.

The photo below illustrates the charcoal canister with the plastic cap in place.
